- 7) Disobeying camp rules and/or curfews.

Any USPC member, parent or chaperone not conforming to the Code of Conduct is subject to the following action: the Officials of this Camp may immediately suspend or expel an individual from this Camp, with no refund of fees, upon consulting with the Maryland Regional Supervisor.

- CURRENT copy of Coggins (must be current during the August 13-16, 2007 period)
- 2007 USPC Medical Release* with ORIGINAL signatures (no photocopies)
- Half Payment of \$175.00 due by July 1st (final \$175.00 payment by August 1st)

OR

- \$350.00 Payment in Full
- \$20.00 additional fee for C3 Prep Applicants ONLY

*Payment includes stall, tack room, and stall bedding; camper's room, all meals, all instruction, all activities and T-shirt. **NOTE: There is a \$10.00 Incomplete/Missing Form Fee, and a \$10.00 Late Fee for payments not received by the due date(s). In case of illness, refunds will be given with a medical excuse minus a \$60.00 withdrawal fee.***

Checklist for Chaperones

- COMPLETED and SIGNED Application.

The chaperone must be a licensed driver and agree to provide transportation for campers to camp activities. The Chaperone must also agree to a background to ensure camper safety.
