Divisions:

Baby Novice – (Pony Club D2) 2006 USEF Novice Eventing Test “A”, Fences up to 24”, courses not timed, Cross country course is very user friendly for first time event riders and their anxious parents!

Beginner Novice – (Pony Club D3) 2006 USEF Novice Eventing Test “A”, Fences to 30”, XC speed 325 meters/minute, Stadium jumping speed 300 meters/minute

Novice – (Pony Club C1-A) 2006 USEF Novice Eventing Test “A”, Fences to 35”, XC speed 350-400 meters/minute, Stadium jumping speed 300 meters/minute

Training - (Pony Club C1-A) 2006 USEF Training Eventing Test “A”, Fences to 39”, XC speed 400-450 meters/minute, Stadium jumping speed 325 meters/minute

Competitors who wish to compete in a division below their current rating level may compete HC (Hors Concours), which means they will not be pinned or have points counted towards the Bedford Bowl.

***Dressage will be ridden in small stone dust arena**

***Stadium will be ridden in an enclosed stone dust ring. Please dress for Cross Country for your Stadium ride, and then proceed directly to Cross Country upon completion of your Stadium ride**

***Cross Country course may be walked after 3 PM on Friday, May 11th or on the day of competition**

***Starting times will be available after 6 PM on Wednesday, May 9th at oldrosetree.ponyclub.org**

***Water is available**

***Delicious food will be available for sale all day**

***Please leave all dogs at home**

Directions to Spring Valley Park: Take I-83 to Glen Rock exit (Exit 8). If traveling north, turn right off the exit and make an immediate right onto Potosi Rd. If traveling south, turn left at end of exit ramp, go under the interstate and turn right onto Potosi Rd. Follow Potosi Rd. for 2.1 miles (through 2 stop signs) and turn left onto Crest Rd. Go ¼ mile and turn right into Park entrance. Trailer parking is on the left. Do not park along the edge of Park entrance road.
