No pony can be shared between Junior & Senior division. Ponies will be allowed to be shared between Novice and Advanced divisions, since these are non-qualifying.

Grounds open at 7:30am

NOTE: Novice Riders will have a delayed arrival, but must be on the grounds by 11:00 a.m.

Briefing – 9:00am

Each team will supply white helmet cover and pinnies or collared shirts/jerseys.

BRING AT LEAST 15 gallons of water per pony

Use the MD Regional team entry forms. Include signed chaperone form

for each team and current coggins for each pony. **Include a photo or swatch of pinney fabric or photo of collared shirt for each team.**

Volunteers: We need 4 lane/line judges per team and 2 lane/line judges for Advanced Pairs to volunteer for either AM or PM shifts. No special skills are required. Instructions will be given before the competitions to all volunteers. Please LIST your 4 volunteers on the ENTRY Form.

MD Regional Qualifying Rally is governed by 2006 USPC Games Rulebook, addendums & 2008 Annual Games Newsletter and 2007 USPC Horse Management Rulebook, addendums & 2008 Annual Horse Management Newsletter.

WALK-TROT (NOVICE) : All members of walk-trot teams must be 9 years of age or less as of January 1 of the year in which they participate in any Games competition. See Section II, Chapter 3, Walk Trot Division, for Special Rules for Competition for this division.

JUNIOR TEAM: All members of a junior team must be 13 years of age or less as of January 1 of the year in which they participate in any official Games Competition (and for Championships, at least 10 years of age and a D-2 rating).

SENIOR TEAM: All members of a senior team must be 17 (for this year only) years of age or less as of January 1 of the year in which they participate in any official Games Competition (and for Championships at least 10 years of age and a D-3 rating).

ADVANCED TEAM: Advanced teams are composed of two members. Both members of an advanced team must be not more than 25 years of age as of January 1 of the year in which they participate in any official Games Competition, and at least one member must be a minimum of 17 years of age as of January 1 of the year in which they participate. No one under the age of 14 as of January 1 of the year in which they participate may compete on an Advanced Team.

ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS ALLOWED, we are serious- persons bringing dogs will be required to leave to the grounds. DCs are responsible for passing this on to parents and spectators.

Directions to Carroll County Equestrian Center:

From Route 70 (Frederick or Baltimore area): Take rt70 east from Frederick or west from Baltimore to Rt 27, Mt. Airy. Travel North on Rt 27, 2 miles to Watersville Rd. Turn right on to Watersville Rd. Travel 1.9 mile to stop sign. Turn right to continue on Watersville Rd. Travel .4 mile to Flag Marsh Rd. Turn left onto Flag Marsh Rd. Travel 1 mile to Grimville Rd. Turn left onto Grimville Rd. Travel .5 mile to Carroll County Equestrian Center on your left.

From Route 270 (Montgomery County area): Take 270 North to Rt 70 East. Follow directions above.
