The clinic will have 3 groups; 18''-2', 2'3''-2'6'' and 3'-3'3''

Each session will be 1½ hours

The focus for the clinic will be form & function and will benefit you & your horse, whether you are preparing for equitation, jumpers or eventing.

Come school the jumps being used for the combined test in the lovely indoor arena with Euro felt footing!!!

The required dress for BOTH the clinic & combined test are ASTM/SEI approved helmets (including dressage rides & warm-up), paddock boots, tall boots, breeches, half chaps, full chaps and neatly attired (no jeans allowed), no jackets required.

NO DOGS ALLOWED!!

Divisions for Combined Test

- 1. Walk/Trot Division - 18" show jumping course, USDF walk/trot test #2 2006**
- 2. Beginner Novice Division - 2'3"-2'6" show jumping course, USEA BN Test B 2009**
- 3. Novice Division - 2'9"-2'11" show jumping course, USEA Novice Test A 2009**
- 4. Training Division - 3'3" show jumping course, USEA Training Test A 2009**

Divisions will be split Jr. & Sr. if there are sufficient entries.

Dressage arenas are in an enclosed grass arena and show jumping courses are in the indoor arena.

Entries for the clinic are limited to 30 participants.

Entries for the combined test will be limited and will be first come, first serve.
