This is a qualifying rally and is open to C1 and up riders (stable managers may be D2 and up).

Developing Horse or Rider Division is also open to D3 riders aged 12 years and older

New for 2009: D3s 12 years and older may qualify for championships in Developing Horse or Rider Division

Teams will consist of 3 or 4 riders, riding any level, and one stable manager

Jumping Levels (per 2008 rule book and 2009 newsletter):

Non-qualifying	2'6"-2'9"	
Developing Horse or Rider*	2'9" – 3'	3'
Large Pony / Horse I	2'6" - 3'3"	3'6"
Horse II	2'9" - 3'6"	3'9"
Horse III	3' - 3'9"	4'0"
Horse IV	3'3" - 4'0"	4'3"

*D3s 12 years and older may enter this division

Each rider will ride three courses. 1 power and speed round (two phase) (Table 2c), 1 Equitation (Normal Knockdown time to count), and 1 jump off (Table 2b).

Clubs are invited to send multiple teams. Scramble teams will be arranged by the organizer when possible.

Rules: This Rally will be run in accordance with the current USPC Show Jumping Rulebook and Horse Management Rulebook, plus their respective addenda. Consult the rulebook for specifications of qualifying rounds.

Facilities: All courses are in outdoor, enclosed arenas, with all-weather footing. Warm-up is centrally located near all arenas.

**You must bring your own water. Please bring enough for a hot day. No water will be available.
No dogs.**

Cost : **\$80.00 per rider**; Stable Managers free

Food: A variety of food choices will be available from our vendor.

Awards: Team Ribbons 1st - 10th place, Equitation Awards 1st - 10th, Horse Management Team Ribbons 1st – 6th
